Riverside Luxury Cruises emerged from opportunity, acquiring Crystal River Cruises' fleet and crew, then applying a simple philosophy to transform river cruising into a floating boutique hotel experience: a maximum 160 guests, all-suite accommodation with panoramic windows, and personal butler service that rivals Europe's grandest resorts.

Their double-width vessels offer more space than standard river ships. The flagship Riverside Mozart sweeps through the Danube, navigating Vienna to Bratislava via UNESCO's Wachau Valley. Riverside Ravel glides along France's Rhône and Saône through Van Gogh's Arles and medieval Avignon, while Riverside Debussy explores the romantic Rhine, from Strasbourg's Gothic cathedral to Dutch Nijmegen and Alsace's wine routes.

Michelin-grade cuisine earned them Cruise Critic's Best Dining award in their inaugural year, with menus evolving regionally: Châteauneuf-du-Pape wines in Provence, Austrian specialities along the Danube, and Dutch delicacies on the Rhine. And parent company The Seaside Collection's luxury hotel expertise is reflected in all the finer details, from flexible 3 to 14-night itineraries to extensive excursion options that let you explore beyond the standard river cruise formula.

When MSC Group's founding family launched Explora Journeys in 2023, they were after yacht-style intimacy with cruise ship convenience.

Built by Fincantieri and staffed by veterans from elite hospitality brands, Explora's two ocean-bound estates (expanding to six by 2028) accommodate just 922 guests across 461 ocean-front suites – all with soaring windows and butler service – starting at 377 square feet. Four superyacht-inspired pool areas replace traditional cruise chaos; multiple restaurants eliminate the dreaded main dining room experience entirely; and the spa uses rejuvenating seawater treatments and marine botanicals.

Their global reach spans 132 ports across 40 countries, with seven-night itineraries extending to 14 or 21 nights through celebrated and off-the-beaten-track destinations, and most sailings offer overnight stays or unconventional timings for in-depth discovery, minus the crowds.

Grand Journeys are exceptional transoceanic, continent-bridging sailings, which include their Amazon Exploration from Puerto Rico to Brazil. And, in 2025, as well as adding Milos, Paros, Portofino, St Tropez and Mahón to their Mediterranean roster, they unveiled their exciting Monaco Formula 1 Grand Prix experience, with exclusive race proximity and high-octane programming.







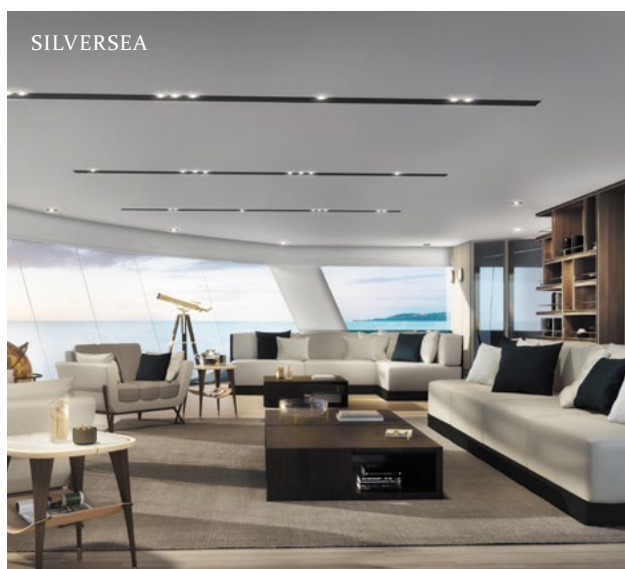

Each of the latter brings Seabourn's distinctively graceful approach to adventure travel, with polar-class construction for accessing more remote regions plus submarine capabilities, scientific equipment and expertise worthy of a research vessel.

From Antarctic penguin colonies and Arctic outposts to Scottish abbeys and remote South Pacific isles, Seabourn's range spans the globe. Their "Everything Included Except the Stress" philosophy eliminates hidden charges, while a relaxed country club atmosphere keeps refreshingly "formal optional" dress codes.

The signature experiences define the Seabourn difference: complimentary caviar service anywhere, anytime; UNESCO partnerships that give greater depth to shore excursions; expert-led Seabourn Conversations; and a Mindful Living programme, founded in collaboration with Dr. Andrew Weil, which offers a flexible variety of activities including yoga, meditation, sound bath therapy and wellness seminars.

FOUR SEASONS EXPLORER PALAU

PACIFIC PARADISE PERFECTION

Four Seasons Explorer Palau transforms expedition cruising with their legendary hotel expertise in one of Earth's most pristine marine sanctuaries. Their floating resort concept allows complete flexibility – daily embarkations and disembarkations with no minimum stay requirements – while maintaining Four Seasons' service standards with 24 crew members attending to just 22 guests.

The 39-metre catamaran's shallow 1.6-metre draft unlocks 193,000 square miles of protected waters and 340 emerald islands, including The Rock Islands Southern Lagoon, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the Seven Underwater Wonders of the World. PADI five-star dive operations feature multilingual dive staff, a marine biologist, and a 6:1 guest-to-dive guide ratio for exploring sites with 100-metre visibility, over 1400 fish species, 500-plus coral varieties, and legendary locations like the Blue Corner, Jellyfish Lake, Chandelier Cave and the Peleliu Wall's dramatic underwater canyons and WWII history.

The cultural experience here centres on Palau's "omengull" philosophy – respecting all existence with ancient stone monoliths, traditional village encounters and waterfall hikes. Spacious air-conditioned staterooms and the palatial Explorer Suite serve as restful bases between expeditions, while expert chefs craft menus around the catch of the day and seasonal island produce.

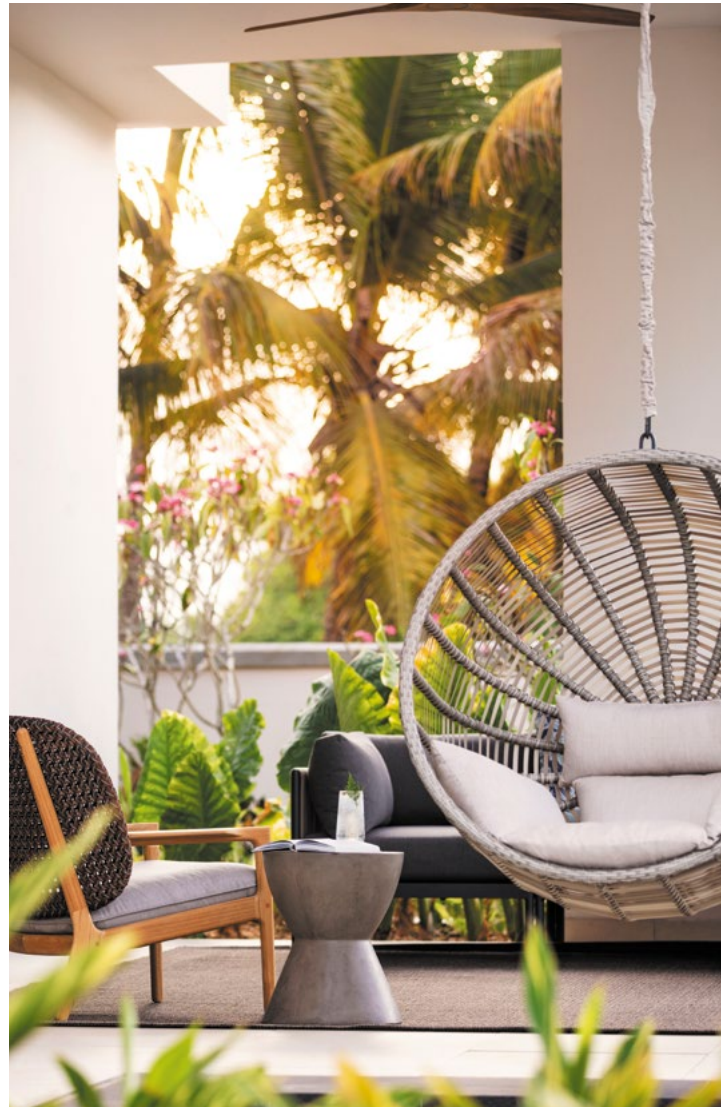

With no menus – just daily conversations crafting tailored dining experiences – and the freedom to lounge at the 45-metre infinity pool, curved impossibly around ancient granite boulders; join in with one or more of the world-renowned conservation projects; take a sunset cruise or guided walk; or go scuba diving, sea kayaking or mountain biking; this all-inclusive, plastic-free paradise proves that true luxury means leaving the world better than you found it.

THE RITZ-CARLTON

DUBAI

September 1998 feels both like yesterday and a lifetime ago. Back then, Dubai Marina was just an idea, The Palm a distant dream. Yet here stood The Ritz-Carlton, Dubai, planted on what would become The Walk, quietly establishing the blueprint for everything that followed.

Twenty-seven years later, it remains refreshingly unchanged, while the emirate transforms around it. The staff genuinely care – not corporate-speak caring, but the kind where they remember your name and individual preferences years later. It’s that rare thing: a hotel that got it right first time and never felt the need to chase trends or reinvent itself.









JUMEIRAH MARSA AL ARAB

DUBAI

We're dropping anchor and spilling all on Dubai's latest hotel launch, the highly anticipated Jumeirah Marsa Al Arab, which, on opening last March, completed the brand's oceanic trilogy on the Jumeirah beachfront alongside its famous siblings, Jumeirah Beach Hotel and Jumeirah Burj Al Arab.

Where others might play it safe with tried and tested formulas, this sleek, superyacht-inspired creation by architect Shaun Killa – the mind behind the Museum of the Future and Dubai Opera – deliberately charts fresh waters. Perched on the tip of a private peninsula, it commands the city's largest stretch of beach with the confidence of a vessel anchored in prime position. The 386 rooms feel genuinely spacious, each with four-metre ceilings and some featuring dramatic 11-metre picture windows that frame the Gulf like living artwork; while the one-, two-, and three-bedroom residences are the embodiment of elegant beachfront living.

Four pools cater to varied moods – from the expansive Resort Pool to the exclusive Illiana Pool Club and chilled-out Kinugawa Adult Pool. The three-floor Talise Spa (with its own 20-metre indoor pool, bathed in natural light and with gorgeous views) sprawls across 3500 square metres, while 11 restaurants and four bars draw inspiration from global destinations. There are also six further restaurants at the 83-berth superyacht marina, designed for more casual dining. It's ambitious without being overwhelming, delivering that rare combination of cutting-edge design and genuine comfort that makes you want to extend your stay indefinitely.

DESERT ADVENTURES

SIX SENSES ZIGHY BAY

OMAN

Imagine arriving by paraglider. That's not marketing hyperbole at Six Senses Zighy Bay – it's one of three James Bond-style entrances alongside arrival by speedboat or a scenic two-hour mountain drive from Dubai.

Hidden in a secluded fishing village on Oman's Mussandam Peninsula, 82 individual stone-walled villas – including the newly renovated Retreats and four-bedroom Private Reserve (the latter offering a 60-foot infinity pool, spa suite, gym, yoga studio, wine cellar and live-in Guest Experience Maker) – are scattered across 18 acres between the towering Hajar Mountains and a mile-long beach. Built from natural stone and warm woods in traditional Omani village style, each villa features high privacy walls, plumped-up sun loungers, a shaded dining area and pool, plus direct beach access and showstopping sunrises from the beachfront options. And all are connected by palm-shaded pathways that encourage barefoot wanderings.

In this scenic and secluded spot, your mobile phone is a distant memory, there's little sound other than the lapping of the waves (and even that's subdued) and, at night, the only lights you'll see are low-level: candles, torches and implausibly bright stars amongst them. Even the alfresco beach cinema is silent, with wireless headphones for every recumbent viewer. It's like witness protection, but with better room service!

Forget everything you think you know about Maldivian design. Jumeirah Olhahali Island's superyacht-inspired, white-washed villas are pure architectural poetry: sleek curves, floor-to-ceiling windows and rooftop terraces that make each sunset feel like an intimate viewing.

The award-winning Talise Spa takes indulgence beneath the waves with overwater glass-bottomed treatment villas; while six exceptional food experiences – Mediterranean beachside at Shimmers, Nikkei fusion at Kayto and all-day international cuisine at Glow – are boosted by unique touches like floating breakfasts, exclusive chef dinners on the pier, cooking masterclasses and sandbank feasts.

Beyond the array of watersports, diving at over 20 dive sites, immersive nature walks, coral-planting workshops, semi-submarine cruises and night snorkels, it's also home to one of the world's most beautiful tennis courts. Add sunset dhoni cruises, a kids' club and wellness activities, plus an inviting ice-cream parlour, and you've a playground for all ages.

Five distinct dining venues include health-centric café Raw, overwater Japanese-Peruvian fusion Salt, and subterranean cellar Vinum, home to 5500+ prestige wines, candlelit cheese and wine tastings and degustation dinners. And, with sandbank picnics and infinity pool dinners, every moment feels totally bespoke.

SIX SENSES LAAMU

MALDIVES

Where dolphins cruise past your overwater villa and surfers paddle out to the famed Yin Yang break, Six Senses Laamu, renowned for its “barefoot luxury” experience, reigns supreme as the sole luxury resort in Laamu Atoll.
